

Great days out from Alnmouth by bus

Using Alnmouth as a starting point, there are some great ways to explore Northumberland without a car. The table below lists the services available and selected running times. Can I get any discounts for using the bus?

Yes you can! The following attractions offer 20% off normal admission to bus users:

- Alnwick Castle and Gardens
- Bailiffgate Museum
- Bamburgh Castle
- Berwick Barracks
- Dunstanburgh Castle
- Etal Castle
- Heatherslaw Cornmill

Just make sure you keep your bus ticket to claim the discounted price when you arrive at the attraction.

What can I do?

There are many great ways to combine the bus with a walk, some great views and a bite to eat. Here are three of our favourites, which all start and finish in Alnmouth.

1. Walk to Warkworth

For a great day out, it's possible to walk along the Northumberland Coast Path to the historic village of Warkworth. It's about five miles away from Alnmouth and has plenty of places for refreshments upon arrival. After refuelling you could visit Warkworth Castle and the Hermitage as well as enjoy a gentle stroll by the river and visit the 14th century bridge. When you're ready to return to Alnmouth, you can either retrace your steps along the Coast Path or instead catch the X18 from the Market Place with possible departures at 15:30, 16:30 or 17:40.

2. Alnwick round trip

If the weather is not looking too good, or you don't feel like walking very far, a day trip to Alnwick is a great option. After catching the 09:31 or 10:41 bus from Alnmouth to Alnwick make the most of your ticket by enjoying

discounted entry at Alnwick Castle and Gardens. There is also the Bailiffgate Museum to visit as well as Barter Books, which is situated inside the town's old train station. When you have finished exploring this old market town, return to the bus station to catch the X18 back to Alnmouth. Services are hourly, with departures including 15:02, 16:12, 17:12 and 18:12.

3. Coastal challenge from Craster

For a long walk, we recommend taking the X18 service to Craster at 09:31. From this harbour village it is about eight miles back to Alnmouth on the Northumberland Coast Path. On the way you'll pass through the small fishing village of Boulmer. There are not very many places to stop along the way, so make sure you take some water and snacks with you to keep energy levels up!

*Buses to Holy Island

Holy Island is tidal so the bus times change daily depending on when low and high tide is and when the causeway is open. For all the most up-to-date information, check the [Perryman's bus timetable](#) before you travel.
