VOLUNTEER ROLE: Graduate Traineeship - Events Ranger

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Working closely with the Coast Care team, AONB Partnership staff and others to

- Organise and deliver a programme of events, walks and talks to engage people with the heritage and habitats of the Northumberland coast
- Recruit and train volunteers to assist with the organisation and running of events
- Promote events through social media, websites and the press
- Assist in evaluating the programme
- Work with private sector partners to deliver events at their sites
- Account for income generated
